Dear Friends,

As everyone knows, 2008 was a difficult and volatile financial year. Despite this, the “spirit of giving” remained alive and well at Ingleside at Rock Creek and Westminster at Lake Ridge. We are grateful for the compassion and caring that was clearly evident in our communities even while the capacity to give was severely stressed by unprecedented declines in market asset values. It is evident that residents, families, businesses, foundations and churches who gave believe in the mission of the Westminster Ingleside Foundation...

The Westminster Ingleside Foundation was established in 2000 and is led by dedicated men and women who give of their time, talents and treasure to help create and support the quality of living and care that exist today. Jack Kleh, chairman emeritus, served from the foundation’s inception through 2006. It has been my privilege to wear the mantel of Board chair since 2007 and to lead this volunteer Board.

Our not-for profit Foundation is the logical out growth of over 100 years of philanthropic intent and ministry. First as The Presbyterian Home of the District of Columbia and now as Ingleside at Rock Creek and her sister community, Westminster Lake Ridge, the Foundation is called to provide financial assistance for residents in need and to maintain and enhance our beautiful communities.


In recent months, “transparency” in financial affairs has become the mantra, and rightly so. As you read this report, I hope that you will find the figures easy to follow and grasp. While the numbers may be discouraging, please know that in this past year we have strengthened our organizational structure, creating policies and procedures that will serve us well in the years to come. More importantly, we are seeing a greater number of contributors extending a helping hand to their neighbors. There is a positive momentum of giving in the air that will help us meet current needs and build for the future.

One of the purposes of the Westminster Ingleside Foundation is to provide a pooled investment portfolio. While funds for each community are used only for the community for which they are designated, joint investments provide for better yield and lower administrative costs. The Foundation’s investment portfolio intentionally held in fixed income securities, nevertheless suffered a sharp decline in (unrealized) value.

Measures were taken during 2008 to reduce the future draw down of the Resident Supporting Fund at Ingleside Rock Creek without compromising the excellent care that current residents are receiving. Admission policies and criteria for using the funds will ensure equitable practices for the future care of residents in need. The Foundation provided oversight and recommendations for these policies and procedures. We do not know all that the future will bring, but we do know that residents will continue to enjoy longer lives than in previous generations and that government and private pensions may not be able to provide for all their financial needs. An endowment for the Resident Supporting fund will help us meet those needs.

Opportunities to give, such as becoming a member of the Living Legacy Society, offer forward thinking donors the ability to provide hope and assurance for a stable and comfortable future for our communities’ residents. My hope for 2009 is that you, your family and friends may further experience the satisfaction of benefitting others by continued support of our now three distinct and lovely communities of Ingleside at Rock Creek, Westminster at Lake Ridge and Ingleside at King Farm.

## WESTMINSTER INGLESIDE FOUNDATION - HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

When the Presbyterian Home of Washington opened in 1906, it had a mission: To provide care and support to retired clergy, missionaries, and congregants. Now, 102 years later, the mission has been expanded at Ingleside Rock Creek (the name it adopted in 1998) and at Westminster at Lake Ridge, a sister community that opened its doors in 1993 to serve the needs of the elderly from today's perspective. Aging no longer signals the end of productive life; it is a new chapter.

To support this mission, the Westminster Ingleside Foundation was chartered in 1999 to encourage and coordinate charitable giving on behalf of residents of both communities. In accordance with the strong tradition of caring for one's neighbors, the mission of the Foundation is simple and straight forward:

- To raise charitable funds to help residents in need
- To enhance the quality of life for all residents
- To build an endowment for the future.

Each campus has an active Development Committee of dedicated volunteers who promote giving for current and future needs through an annual appeal to the Resident Supporting Fund, and through estate gifts and planned giving. Working with the Development Committees are two Development professionals, Constance Miller at Westminster at Lake Ridge, and Robert Lancelotta who came to Ingleside at Rock Creek in March 2009.

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Members of the Living Legacy Society, founded in 2003, are honored each year at a special celebration in June. The 2008 recognition dinner for members from both campuses was held at the Ingleside Rock Creek Manor House. Living Legacy Society members include those individuals who have made provision through bequests, charitable gift annuities, or other planned gifts for Westminster or Ingleside in their estate plans.

Living Legacy Society Members recognize that they have benefited from the foresight of residents who preceded them, whose generosity helped create and enhance the community life that we all enjoy. In turn, Living Legacy members wish to help preserve for future residents the special spirit and vibrant community that makes Ingleside and Westminster what it is today. The names of the Living Legacy Society Members may be seen on the attractive wall plaque at each community. We thank and honor these generous and caring donors who are also recorded in this report.

In September of 2008, both campuses held Resident Supporting Fund Appreciation Luncheons. Entertainment and good food made these events enjoyable as well as educational. Additionally, two seminars were sponsored by the Development Committees at each community on estate planning and planned giving. Both campuses have additional information in the Development Offices on estate planning resources and experts available.

## **GREETINGS FROM JOHN SHERMAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE INGLESIDE AT ROCK CREEK RESIDENT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

The year 2008 can be characterized for Ingleside by a single word: "CHANGE". Whether it was prompted by the formidable array of external forces with which we are all familiar, or those essentially unique to Ingleside, it was a remarkable period in and of itself and for the institution's future. In contrast to the negative forces in financial markets and the economy, however, the changes occurring at Ingleside were generally positive and augured well for the future. As the year unfolded, the significance of those modifications became more apparent.

A case in point was the concerted effort to clarify and consistently apply appropriate qualifications of eligibility for financial assistance to residents from the Resident Supporting Fund. Discussions within the Development Committee and with management highlighted the need to address that situation promptly. A further concern was the lack of adequate and timely data for monitoring contributions and financial operations of the Foundation.

During the year there were several successful activities specifically related to fund raising. The always much appreciated Women's Board Annual Silver Tea took place on Sunday, May 4, a highlight of Spring at Ingleside. A well-attended Appreciation Luncheon for contributors on September 18 marked the Annual Kick-Off of the Resident Supporting Fund Campaign. Special thanks are in order for the stirring talk by long-time Ingleside resident, Louise Winfield, and her challenge to residents like herself to recognize the importance and reward of regular giving even though the amount might be comparatively small. In October residents, like those at Westminster, had an opportunity to learn about Estate Planning from professionals Donald Wright and William Clayton Batchelor.

In summary, 2008 was indeed a year of change requiring patience as well as purposeful activity while awaiting the implementation of needed modifications. At the same time, the invaluable dedication demonstrated throughout the year by members of the Resident Development Committee merits special recognition.

## **GREETINGS FROM MAC GERLACH, CHAIRMAN OF THE WESTMINSTER AT LAKE RIDGE RESIDENT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

Recently, many of us witnessed one or more Memorial Day ceremonies here or across the United States. I was again struck by the dedication and caring spirit of the American people. While we may take a lot for granted, we do band together to protect our national family when pressed.

We at Westminster are a microcosm of that same bond. We too are family, and willingly and generously ensure support for members of our family with our time and monetary resources. The Resident Supporting Fund (RSF) is one way we show our compassion for residents in financial difficulty.

And so, there were some encouraging rays of hope amidst the economic gloom of 2008. An all time high of 57% of the Westminster independent residents gave to the Resident Supporting Fund. In 2007, 48% contributed. We are indeed grateful for each person who responded, and truly see ourselves as family helping family.

Given the challenging economic times, the Resident Development Committee is searching for new ways to maintain and even increase participation. Committee Members hope to encourage gifts both large and small in 2009. Soon we will be announcing a new program to increase gifts given to the RSF "in honor of" residents. The Committee would also like to enhance the use of technology to increase awareness of giving opportunities on line and through the WLR TV channel.

Lastly, we recognize that it is through estate planning that major gifts will most likely be contributed to fund an endowment of \$3 million, the target that we would like to see in place by our 20th anniversary in 2013. In 2008, there were excellent presentations by Donald Wright and William Clayton Batchelor on the tax and other advantages of estate planning. Our hope is that many residents will recognize that Westminster is their home and family and make provision for its lively continuation through estate planning.

On behalf of the Westminster Resident Development Committee, we thank each and every donor for their commitment to our community.

**NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The year 2008 was unprecedentedly difficult for both the goals and the results of the Foundation. The uncertainties and concerns generated by the global recession took a severe toll on the capacity of donors to be generous, and on the value of the Foundation's investments. Though the number of contributors actually increased, the number of large gifts and gift annuities dropped sharply. Similarly, though the Foundation's investments were almost exclusively in traditionally safer fixed income securities, the portfolio nevertheless incurred a \$300,000 unrealized loss in 2008 (on a year-end 2007 value of \$1.6 million).

Total fundraising expenses in 2008 were held to \$258 thousand, roughly the same level they had been for several years. Nevertheless, because of the sharp decline in contributions, the fundraising expense ratio rose to an unprecedented and unacceptable level of 48 percent. The Foundation Board is carefully examining what steps can be taken to reduce this ratio, particularly in light of the continuing difficult economic environment. Fortunately, the need for financial assistance in 2008 by Ingleside residents fell very sharply (primarily because a number were able to qualify for Federal Medicaid funds), thus bringing the need for resident support into closer balance with the reduced level of contributions.
